

#### Index of releases

- The next release of Debian is codenamed "bookworm" "testing" no release date has been set
- Debian 11 ("bullseye") current "stable" release
- Debian 10 ("buster") current "oldstable" release
- Debian 9 ("stretch") "oldoldstable" release, under LTS support
- Debian 8 ("jessie") archived release, under extended LTS support
- Debian 7 ("wheezy") obsolete stable release
- Debian 6.0 ("squeeze") obsolete stable release
- Debian GNU/Linux 5.0 ("lenny") obsolete stable release
- Debian GNU/Linux 4.0 ("etch") obsolete stable release
- <u>Debian GNU/Linux 3.1 ("sarge")</u> obsolete stable release
- Debian GNU/Linux 3.0 ("woody") obsolete stable release
- Debian GNU/Linux 2.2 ("potato") obsolete stable release
- Debian GNU/Linux 2.1 ("slink") obsolete stable release
- <u>Debian GNU/Linux 2.0 ("hamm")</u> obsolete stable release

Sid is a codename of version development and testing for the next version stable, for example "bookworm".


## Debian Sid, unstable and testing

220 number Team Package Tracker


Unstable – packages untest

The Debian Security Team only support on stable release.

All packages support for maintainers (team or persona)

#### Installing Debian Sid

Recommended install minimal stable system ISO

Change source to unstable or testing

- # /etc/apt/sources.list Change line
- deb https://deb.debian.org/debian unstable main
- deb https://deb.debian.org/debian testing main

#### Easy way update and secure Sid

**Disable - Unattended Upgrades** 

**Update** -

check package

apt upgrade ← apt full-upgrade

package problem → apt-mark

apt-listbugs / apt-listchanges

Live USB

backups always

system file btrfs – timesshift
